

# LOCAL RULES

## EMERALD COURSE

### 1. OUT OF BOUNDS:

- Beyond any fence or hedge on the perimeter of the course.
- The car park.
- The practice putting green and adjoining flower beds and beyond the white posts to the left of the 18th green.
- To the right of the 1st hole on the hotel grounds and par 3 course.

### 2. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

### 3. POP UP SPRINKLERS

All pop up sprinklers are immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction, on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played, intervene between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief as follows:

- If the ball lies on the putting green, it may be lifted and placed, not nearer the hole, at the nearest point at which intervention by the obstruction is avoided.
  - If the ball lies off the putting green (but not in a hazard) and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, not nearer the hole, at the nearest point at which intervention by the obstruction is avoided.
- ### 4. TYRE MARKS
- Deep rutted motor vehicle tyre marks may be treated as ground under repair. Rule 25-1 applies.

### 5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

The following are deemed to be immovable obstructions and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2.

- All blue, red and yellow stakes.
- All man made stone or gravel surfaced paths or roads.
- All man made stoned areas, except in hazards. Manhole and water hydrant covers and posts.

### 6. WATER HAZARDS

All unmarked water hazards, or those marked with yellow stakes are ordinary water hazards. Rule 26-1a and b apply.

### 7. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Areas of ground under repair are defined by blue stakes or 'GJR' signs. Play is prohibited from these areas, relief to be taken under Rule 25-1.

### 8. AERIFICATION HOLES AND GROUND DAMAGED BY SLITTING

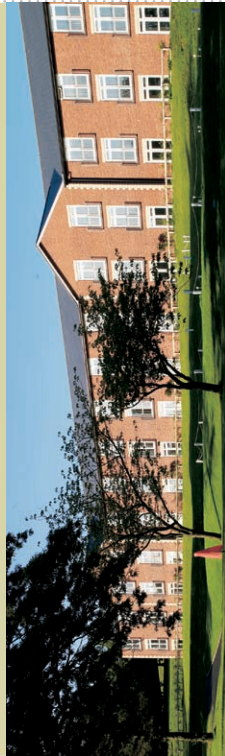
If a ball comes to rest in an aeration hole or on ground disturbed by slitting, the player may lift and clean the ball. Through the green, the player shall drop the ball as near as possible to where it lay, but not nearer the hole. On the putting green, the player shall place the ball at the nearest spot not nearer the hole which avoids such situation.

### 9. NEWLY PLANTED TREES

Lift and drop within one club-length, not nearer the hole. Rule 25-1 applies.
